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Subject : The Revenue Department advises election candidates on the request for copies

of tax returns

According to the Organic Act on the Election of Members of the House of Representatives B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 45 and Section 57 require a house of representative candidate, either for constituency election or for party-list proportional representation, to provide evidence of personal income tax payment for three consecutive years immediately prior to the year of registration for election of that candidate.

Mr. Pinsai Suraswadi, Acting Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Finance and Banking) as Spokesperson of the Revenue Department, reveals that the house of representative candidates for the constituency election and for party-list proportional representation, who want to request copies of previously filed personal income tax returns (P.N.D.90 or P.N.D.91) for three consecutive years immediately prior to the year of registration for election (tax year 2016, tax year 2017, and tax year 2018), can request for their copies of P.N.D.90 or P.N.D.91 tax returns from the Revenue Department as they are the owners of information.

For the candidate who filed P.N.D.90 or P.N.D.91 tax return online, he or she can contact the Area Revenue Office with jurisdiction over the area of residence as stated in the tax return or contact the Electronic Processing Administration Division on the 27th floor, the Revenue Department Building: Tel. 0-2272-9205.

For the candidate who filed P.N.D.90 or P.N.D.91 tax return in paper, he or she can contact the Area Revenue Office with jurisdiction over the area of residence as stated in the tax return or contact the Office of the Secretary on the 20th floor, the Revenue Department Building: Tel. 0-2272-8589.
