Subject : The Revenue Department has launched a new mobile web application for the public to report information on tax evasion via mobile phone and website

The Revenue Department has launched a new mobile web application for the public to report information on tax evasion to the Revenue Department via mobile phone and Revenue Department's website, in order to create a fair tax system and expand the tax base. The application has been launched since 1st January 2018.

Mr. Prasong Poontaneat, Director-General of the Revenue Department, revealed that, "Some businesses are not compliant; for example, cash economy businesses and online businesses are still not registered and operate outside the tax system. One cause may be the lack of knowledge and understanding of tax compliance. Accordingly, the Revenue Department has developed a mobile web application for the public to report information such as information of businesses that don't issue tax invoices or issue incorrect tax invoices, businesses that charge additional VAT when customers ask for tax invoices as well as any suspected activity of tax evasion. The public can report such information including photos and locations of the suspicious businesses in 5 easy steps via the Revenue Department's website (www.rd.go.th). All information will be kept confidential and is protected by law. The Revenue Department believes that this application will create a fair tax system, expand the tax base, and strengthen Thailand's revenue stability in the long run.
