Subject : Tax refund via PromptPay

Mrs. Patricia Mongkhonvanit, Principle Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) as Spokesperson of the Revenue Department, clarified that, “Since 1st January 2018, taxpayers have filed personal income tax returns for tax year 2017. Taxpayers who file electronic tax returns via either www.rd.go.th or RD Smart Tax Application with the registration of PromptPay by 13 digits of National ID Number, and are not subjected to tax audit before the refund, will be the first group to receive tax refund via PromptPay.”

The spokesperson added that, “The Revenue Department has started to send tax refund information to the banks. If a taxpayer has registered for PromptPay with 13 digits of National ID Number, the bank will transfer the refund to the account on the next working day. Therefore, the Revenue Department would like to encourage taxpayers to file personal income tax returns via electronic channels and register for PromptPay with 13 digits of National ID Number. Taxpayers will receive tax refund correctly, conveniently and promptly.”
