Subject : The Revenue Department reminds businesses about the deadline for filing corporate income tax returns

Mrs. Patricia Mongkhonvanit, Deputy Director-General, Acting Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) and Spokesperson of the Revenue Department, announced that, “Companies, juristic partnerships, foundation and association or any other legal entity that having accounting periods ending on 31st December 2017 are required by law to file annual corporate income tax returns (P.N.D. 50 / P.N.D. 52 / P.N.D. 55) within 150 days from the last day of the accounting period. The filing deadline is 30th May 2018. For those submitting tax returns online via www.rd.go.th will get an extension of 7 days for tax return filing and tax payment until 7th June 2018.”
