**Subject** : The Revenue Department clarifies about the additional documents to support personal income tax refund claims for tax year 2017

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Some taxpayers have received email scams requesting additional documents to support personal income tax refund claims for tax year 2017. They have been asked to send the documents including copies of National ID cards via [www.e-revenue.go.th](http://www.e-revenue.go.th) and to disclose their 13 digit National ID numbers and telephone numbers.

The Revenue Department would like to clarify that the Revenue Department does not have a policy to request a copy of National ID card for personal income tax refund claims. If the Revenue Department requests any supporting documents from taxpayers, they must submit the documents via 4 channels;

1. By fax to the number as notified by the Revenue Department
2. By post
3. By themselves
4. Via internet at [www.rd.go.th](http://www.rd.go.th) using the same username and password for e-Filing
