**Subject** : Suan Dusit Poll revealed that the Revenue Department received satisfaction of the people from extension for filing Personal Income Tax returns until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020

The online poll of Suan Dusit University revealed that the extension for filing tax returns of P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91 until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 climbed on the top of a survey of people's satisfaction on remedial measures of the Government.

**Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) spokesman of the Revenue Department** revealed that “the online survey of Suan Dusit Poll of Suan Dusit University from nationwide people collected between 27<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020 on “Satisfaction with Government measures against Covid-19: The remedial measures of the Government satisfied by the people” indicated that the extension for filing Personal Income Tax returns until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 of the Revenue Department was on the top of rank by 83.5 percent of the votes. The Revenue Department believed that this will help the taxpayers to be safe from Covid-19 pandemic and conform to the Government's policy inviting people to stay at home, to reduce human movement, to promote Social Distancing campaign and to increase cash flow of the taxpayers. These will therefore improve the standard of living as well as the national economy of the country.”
