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Subject : The Revenue Department is able to collect taxes more than the target 22 billion baht in the first seven months of the fiscal year 2019

Mr. Pinsai Suraswadi, the Spokesperson of the Revenue Department, revealed that the Revenue Department is able to collect tax in the first seven month of the fiscal year 2019 (October 2018 - April 2019) in the amount of 956,684 million baht which is greater than that of the target shown on the budget (2 ten billion baht) by 22,314 million baht or 2.4 percent and greater than that of previous year by 57,251 million baht or 6.4 percent as follows:

- **Petroleum Income Tax** collected 23,695 million baht, greater than the target in the amount of 19,525 million baht due to the accelerator of tax collection and a rise of average oil price.

- **Special Business Tax** collected 36,184 million baht, greater than the target in the amount of 2,149 million baht due to the accelerator of immovable property transfer before the enforcement of the control measure for the second home loan on April 2019.

- **Stamp Duty** collected 9,447 million baht, greater than the target of 424 million baht, due to the increment of tax collection monitoring for contract and instrument from the public and private investment project and the increment of immovable property transfer.

The Spokesperson also added that in the second half of the fiscal year 2019 the ratio of tax collection is expanded in the decreasing rate as of the fluctuation of economics and world's trade. However, the Revenue Department can enhance the efficiency of tax collection by promoting tax compliance via digital service public relations. Tax Filing Monitoring can be performed by using data analytics to analyze filing data to ensure that taxpayers pay their taxes in accordance with their fact, track important taxpayers in the region, integrate both external and internal data to link towards real income of taxpayers, as well as increasing efficiency of operations.

In addition, the Revenue Department is confident that tax collection in the fiscal year 2019 will be greater than the target shown in the budget 2,000,000 million baht that is imperative to the national financial stability and sustainability.
