Subject : 31st August 2020, the extended deadline of personal income tax return (P.N.D 90 and P.N.D 91) filing for tax year 2019 via internet and Area Revenue Branch Office is approaching

The Revenue Department has suggested more than 2 million taxpayers who have not filed personal income tax return (P.N.D. 90/91) for tax year 2019 to submit tax returns by 31st August 2020 and recommended the electronic filing system as a convenient and easy method for making tax payment and installment. Taxpayers with a refund request should apply Promptpay to get tax refund faster.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) and spokesperson of the Revenue Department revealed that “Because of COVID-19 pandemic, the Revenue Department is deeply concerned about taxpayers’ safety. Therefore, the Revenue Department has encouraged all taxpayers to use electronic filing system to file personal income tax return (P.N.D. 90/91) and extended the deadline for tax year 2019 from 31st March 2020 to 31st August 2020. According to the number of tax return filing for tax year 2019 from 1st January 2020 to 2nd August 2020, there are over 9.57 million taxpayers have filed tax returns whereas there are more than 2 million taxpayers have not filed tax returns, in comparison with, the number of taxpayers filing tax return (P.N.D. 90/91) for tax year 2018 is 11.57 million taxpayers. Consequently, any person reaching income threshold in accordance with the law is required to file a tax return. The Revenue Department has encouraged taxpayers to file their tax returns via www.rd.go.th or RD Smart Tax Application on smartphone, for P.N.D. 91 in particular, to save time and receive a quick tax refund, and be better fit for a new Thai lifestyle in the “New Normal” era.”

The spokesperson additionally stated that “Taxpayers can check details of their tax deductions and tax allowances such as charitable donation (e-donation), social security contributions, government pension fund and health insurance premium, through “My Tax Account” system at www.rd.go.th.”
