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Subject : The Revenue Department recommends re-printing the Pay-In Slips if it is expired for personal income tax returns (P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D. 91) in order to pay tax within 31st August 2020

The Revenue Department suggests individual taxpayers, who have already filed personal income tax returns (P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D. 91) online but have not made a payment, to check their Pay-In Slips. If it is overdue, please print a new Pay-In Slip on the Revenue Department website at www.rd.go.th in order to get extended tax payment date to 31st August 2020.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry), and the spokesperson of the Revenue Department revealed that, “the Revenue Department encourages individual taxpayers to file P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D. 91 online. If there is tax payable, the taxpayer can make a payment electronically through various channels, such as e-Payment, Internet Banking, and Mobile Banking. For those who have printed out the Pay-In Slips, please check the due dates. If it is overdue and has not been paid, please login to the e-Filing system and print a new Pay-In Slip in order to get extended tax payment date to 31st August 2020. Moreover, the Revenue Department has cooperated with 20 leading banks to waive the fees for electronic tax payment, until 31st December 2020.”
