**Subject** : More than 7.42 million Personal Income Tax returns, P.N.D.90 and P.N.D. 91, have been filed to the Revenue Department and more than 90% of which have been made online, as e-Filing provides easy and convenient way, as well as, it helps taxpayers stay safe and keep them away from COVID-19

The Revenue Department has released the number of Personal Income Tax return filings, P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91, for the tax year 2020. From 1<sup>st</sup> January to 18<sup>th</sup> April 2021, there have been 7,428,132 tax returns submitted and more than 90% of them have been made online through e-Filing service, as it is easy, convenient and available anytime from anywhere. The filing period for this year is extended to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 only for submitting online. Taxpayers can submit tax returns at home (TAX from Home). This can keep them staying safe and reduce the spread of COVID-19.

**Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) spokesman of the Revenue Department** revealed that “from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 18<sup>th</sup> April 2021, the number of Personal Income Tax return filings, P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91, submitted for the tax year 2020 were 7,428,132 forms. There have been 6,707,208 forms (90.29 percent of total) submitted online, while 720,924 forms (9.71% of total) have been paper tax return filings. The tax return filings can be categorised as follows;

For P.N.D.90, 1,782,516 forms have been filed, accounted for 1,351,756 forms submitted online and 430,760 forms submitted as paper tax returns.

For P.N.D.91, 5,645,616 forms have been filed, accounted for 5,355,452 forms submitted online and 290,164 forms submitted as paper tax returns.

The taxpayers using our e-Filing services were accounted for 90.29 percent of total tax return filings since the Revenue Department has developed a new website and also improved the e-Filing system to be easier, more convenient, and faster for taxpayers to submit the forms. In addition, this year, the Revenue Department has extended the filing due date of P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D. 91 forms to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021, particularly for the online filing channel. Thus, the taxpayers who have not submitted tax returns yet can do online. This can promote the Revenue Department’s TAX from HOME campaign, allowing taxpayers to process tax transactions at ease, anytime and anywhere, in all dimensions including registration, tax return filings, tax payment, and refund inquiries.”

**The spokesman of the Revenue Department** added that “during the COVID-19 pandemic, Tax from Home would be a great help for all taxpayers to be convenient, stay safe, be less dependent on traveling, and keep social distancing to efficiently prevent the spread of COVID-19”
