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Subject : No fines and surcharges when filing P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D. 91 online by 30th June 2021

The Revenue Department encouraged income earners to submit P.N.D.90 or P.N.D.91 online by 30th June 2021, including government officials, office workers, agents, lessors, independent professionals, contractors and online merchants who have not yet submitted any tax returns. They can file tax returns at home or TAX from Home, as well as make requests for 3-installment payment of tax with fast and convenient online tax services.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) as a spokesperson of the Revenue Department revealed that, “Now, it was very close to the deadline for filing the personal income tax returns, i.e., P.N.D.90 and P.N.D. 91, for the tax year 2020, which the Revenue Department has already extended the deadline for e-filing until 30th June 2021. As of 20th June 2021, more than 9.535 million tax returns had been submitted. However, there were those who have not filed the tax returns yet. In order to avoid fines and surcharges, the Revenue Department would like to encourage income earners such as government officials, state enterprise employees, office workers, agents or brokers, lessors, independent professionals including physicians and nurses, architects, engineers, accountants, contractors, online sellers, celebrities, actors and professional athletes, who had income in the tax year 2020 but have not yet filed any tax returns, to submit the tax returns online at www.rd.go.th no later than 30th June 2021. In terms of taxpayers with more than 3,000 baht in tax, they can make requests for their tax payments for 3 installments. Also, taxpayers can check the list of tax deductions by themselves from My Tax Account via the Revenue Department’s website.”

The Revenue Department’s spokesperson added that, “During COVID-19, we would like to encourage taxpayers to do electronic transactions at home or TAX from Home because it is fast, easy, convenient, no need to travel, safe and social-distance. This can help reduce and prevent the spread of the COVID-19 as well.”
