Subject : To boost individuals' cash flow, the Revenue Department has refunded tax to more than 91 percent of the 3.4 million tax refund requests by individual taxpayers

The Revenue Department has swiftly refunded tax for tax year 2020 for 3,062,532 tax refund requests out of 3,401,688 tax refund requests which is 91 percent completed. The total amount of the tax refund was 30,685 million Baht. Taxpayers who filed a tax return, requested a tax refund online with all documents attached, and linked their PromptPay account with their identification number have already received the tax refund.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry), as the Spokesperson of the Revenue Department stated that, "The Revenue Department has been speeding up the tax refund processes for personal income tax returns (P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91) of tax year 2020. 3,062,532 tax refund requests has been completed out of 3,401,688 tax refund requests which is 91 percent and the total amount of tax refund is 30,685 million Baht (as of 28th June 2021). Taxpayers who filed a tax return, requested a tax refund online with all documents attached, and linked their PromptPay account with their identification number have already received the tax refund. However, for those who have not received tax refund, the status can be tracked 24/7 at www.rd.go.th."

The Spokesperson of Revenue Department also made the following final remark that, "The deadline for e-filing of personal income tax return (P.N.D. 90 and P.N.D.91) for tax year 2020 is 30th June 2021. Until now, there has been 10,031,924 tax returns submitted. For those who have not filed the personal income tax return (P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91), the Revenue Department suggests to file the tax return on the due time in order to prevent penalties and surcharges. Additionally, we encourage the use of Tax from Home since it is more convenient, fast, safe, and to maintain social distancing to prevent the spread of COVID-19."
