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Subject : The Revenue Department has prepared electronic tax filing system of personal income tax for tax year 2019

The Revenue Department has prepared electronic tax filing system via the Revenue Department website and mobile application. In addition, the filers can verify the information about their allowances via “My Tax Account” at www.rd.go.th, in order to reduce document keeping burden and increase efficiency in searching data on allowances e.g. GPF contribution fund, health insurance premium and contribution via e-donation. This will facilitate and speed up personal income tax filing and tax refund process.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, acting Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration as spokesperson of the Revenue Department, revealed that “The income tax return filing of tax year 2019 is designated to be filed within 31st March 2020 or for the person who files via internet will get 8 day extension until 8th April 2020. To be noted, filing of income tax return via internet accounts for 82 percent of the overall filing, thus the Revenue Department has prepared for online tax filing system and mobile application system to be in accordance with various tax benefits for tax payers. The systems will be ready for online tax filing from 1st January 2020.”

“When filing the personal income tax return, the tax payers have to declare their incomes and allowances in order to receive tax benefits and pay tax correctly. The Revenue Department is aware of such importance; therefore, the Revenue Department creates a portal for taxpayers to check the information about various tax allowances via “My Tax Account” system at www.rd.go.th. My Tax Account is a system which allows taxpayers to do a research on tax allowances and tax benefits by linking information in electronic format with various organizations, and show tax allowances information e.g. health insurance premium, contribution via e-donation and Government Provident Fund contribution. This system, which serves more than 800,000 users last year, will help reduce the burden in document keeping and scanning and will facilitate and speed up personal income tax filing and tax refund process.”

“Online tax filing will allow faster tax refund compared with paper filing. In case there is no need for additional documents, the system will automatically

refund the tax by transferring money into taxpayers' Prompt Pay accounts or e-Money/e-Wallet cards. To be noted, from 1st January to 30th September 2019 the Revenue Department had approved tax refund for the total amount of 34 million Baht. Within this amount, more than 29 million Baht which accounts for 86.86 percent was the tax refund paid via Prompt Pay accounts and e-Money”, said the spokesperson of the Revenue Department.
