Subject : The Revenue Department extends personal income tax filing deadline to 31st August 2020

As some citizens are worried that they might have to come out and visit the Revenue Department to file and pay their taxes by 31st March 2020,

Mr. Ekniti Nitithanprapas, Director-General of the Revenue Department revealed that “because of the COVID-19 epidemic, the Revenue Department is deeply concerned about both taxpayers and officers’ safety. The Revenue Department decides to extend personal income tax filing deadline (P.N.D. 90/91) for the tax year 2019 from 31st March 2020 to 31st August 2020.

As an organization that serve the taxpayers, all the Revenue Department area and branch offices are still open. However, Revenue Department officers are informed to strictly adhere to the social distancing measure as a precaution to the COVID-19 epidemic. Taxpayers might experience some inconvenience from our services.

The Revenue Department strongly encourages all taxpayers to use our electronic services such as electronic income tax filing (e-Filing), Mobile Application RD Smart tax instead of coming to the Revenue branch office. We are adamant to abide by the social distancing measure as a precaution to the COVID-19 epidemic.”
